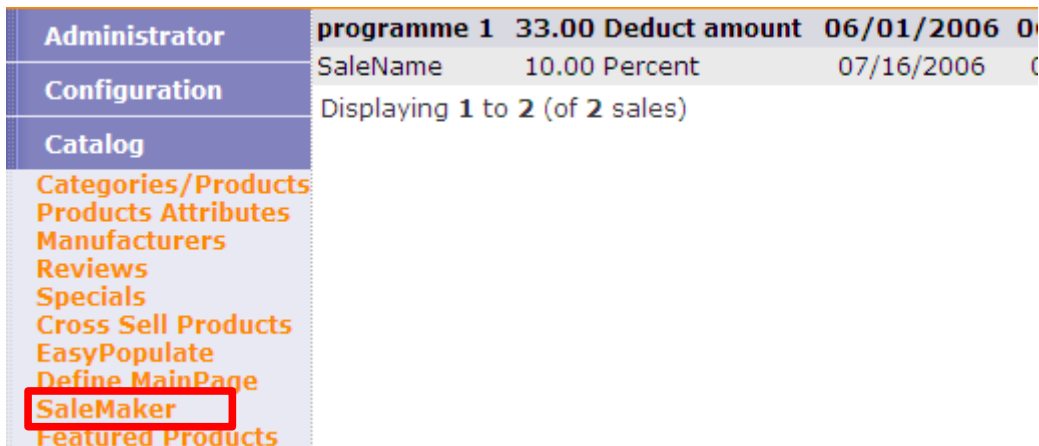

## Introduction

From the Sale Maker section of Admin Panel you can set up sales for the products contained in the Catalog. The sale price will show up in red color next to the “original” price on the main page, category info page, and product info page.

### Creating A New Sale

1. From Admin Panel of the web-store click the **Catalog** link and select the **Sale Maker** item.



2. Click the **New Sale** button to create a new sale.



3. In the **SaleName** field, specify a name of a sale.

4. In the **Deduction** field you can specify an amount or percentage to deduct, or a replacement price. (e.g. deduct \$5.00 from all prices, deduct 10% from all prices or change all prices to \$25.00). In the **Type** field select a type of diduction: Deduct Amount, Percent, or New Price.

Note:

- ◆ Always use a '.' as decimal point in deduction.
- ◆ Enter amounts in the same currency as you would when creating/editing a product.

5. In the fields located opposite the **Products Pricerange**, specify a range of product prices which this sale will be applied to. Entering a price range narrows down the product range that will be affected. (e.g. products from \$50.00 to \$150.00).

6. Click the “down” arrow adjacent to the **If a product is a Special** field. In the dropdown list, select an action to take if a product is a special.

- **Ignore Specials Price**  
The sale deduction will be applied to a regular price of a product (e.g. a regular price is \$10.00, a special price is \$9.50, a sale condition is 10%. The product's final price will be \$9.00 on sale. The Specials Price will be ignored.)
  - **Ignore Sale Condition**  
The sale deduction will not be applied to Specials. The Specials price will show just like when there is no sale defined. (e.g. a regular price is \$10.00, a special price is \$9.50, a sale condition is 10%. The product's final price will be \$9.50 on sale. The Sales Condition will be ignored.)
  - **Apply Sale Condition to Specials Price**  
The sale deduction will be applied to the Specials price. A compounded price will be shown. (e.g. a regular price is \$10.00, a special price is \$9.50, a sale condition is 10%. The product's final price will be \$8.55. An additional 10% off the Specials price.)
7. In the **Start Date** and **End Date** fields, specify the starting and ending dates for the Sale's activity. You can select a date from Calendar by clicking the "**arrow**" icon adjacent to the field.
- Leaving the Start date empty will start the sale immediately.
  - Leave the End date empty if you do not want the sale to expire.

## Setting Up Categories To Apply Sale

1. From the Admin Panel > Catalog > Sale Maker screen you can set up categories/sub-categories a sale to be applied to.
2. Select the **Entire Catalog** checkbox to apply a sale to ALL the products in Catalog.

▶ Check this box if you want the sale to be applied to **all products**:
