Introduction

From the Admin Panel > Configuration > GZip Compression section you can set up Gzip features allowing to compress your web-store, in order the users can work with it faster.

Updating Enable GZip Compression

1. Go to **Admin Panel > Configuration** section and select the **Gzip Compression** item.




2. Since the **Enable GZip Compression** item is highlighted, click the **Edit** button on the right.

- Select the **True** button to enable HTTP GZip Compression. This allows to compress the HTTP site and thus to decrease size of the website attributes (header, images, boxes, etc), in order to load the web-pages faster.
 - Select the **False** button if you do not want to activate this feature.
3. Click the **Update** button.

Updating Compression Level

1. From the Admin Panel click the **Configuration** link and select the **Gzip Compression** item.
2. Select the **Compression Level** item in the list and click the **Edit** button.

3. In the field, specify the compression level.
Note:
 - 0 is the minimum level
 - 9 is the maximum level
 - The default level is 5 – the optimal and recommended one for safe work of your server.
4. Click the **Update** button.
