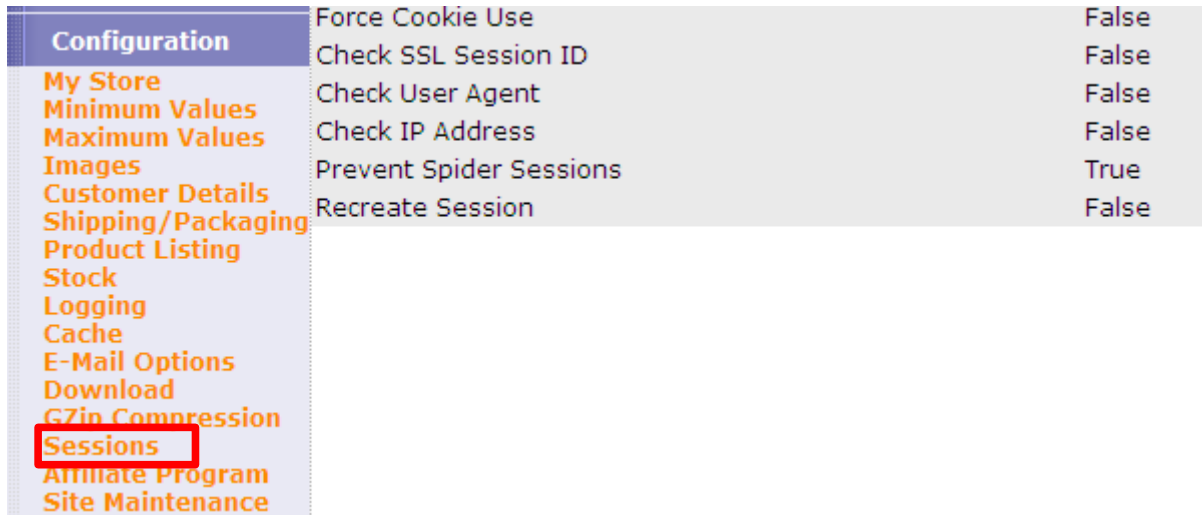

Introduction

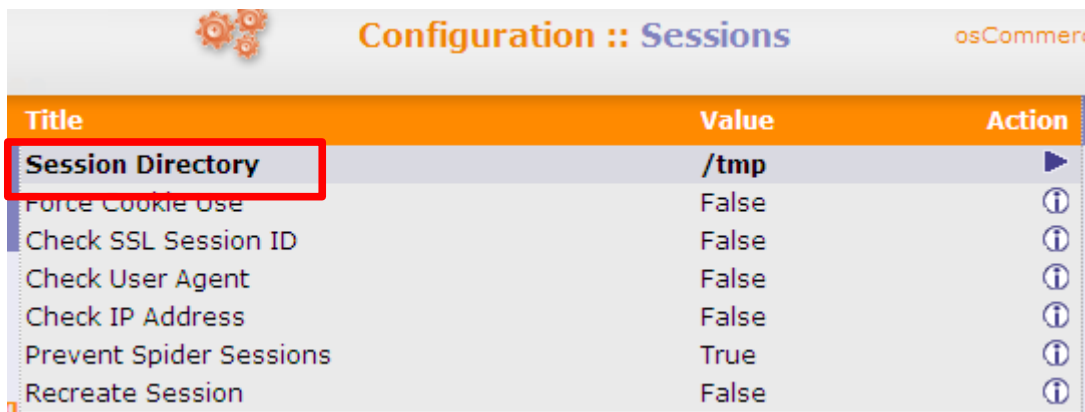
From the Admin Panel > Configuration > Sessions section you can set up your web-store visiting sessions.

Updating Session Directory

1. Go to **Admin Panel > Configuration** section and select the **Sessions** item.



2. Since the **Session Directory** item is highlighted, click the **Edit** button on the right.



3. In the field, specify a directory name for storing of the sessions files (if these are file-based). A session is created when a user visits the web-store.
4. Click the **Update** button.

Updating Force Cookie Use

1. From the **Admin Panel > Configuration** section select the **Sessions** item.
2. Select the **Force Cookie Use** item in the list and click the **Edit** button on the right.

- Select the **True** button to force using of sessions only when cookies are enabled. It means if cookies are disabled in user's current browser, a user will be shown a message on the page forcing him/her to enable cookies.



2. Select the **Check SSL Session ID** item in the list and click the **Edit** button on the right.



- Select the **True** button to validate the SSL Session ID on every secure HTTPS page request. This feature is used for safe navigation from HTTP to HTTPS pages.
 - Select the **False** button if you do not want to activate checking of SSL Session ID while requesting HTTPS page.
3. Click the **Update** button.

Updating Check User Agent

1. From the Admin Panel click the **Configuration** link and select the **Sessions** item.
2. Select the **Check User Agent** item in the list and click the **Edit** button on the right.





2. Select the **Check IP Address** item in the list and click the **Edit** button on the right.



1. From of the Admin Panel click the **Configuration** link and select the **Sessions** item.
2. Select the **Prevent Spider Session** item in the list and click the **Edit** button.



1. From the Admin Panel click the **Configuration** link and select the **Sessions** item.
2. Select the **Recreate Session** item in the list and click the **Edit** button.
