Introduction

From the Admin Panel > Configuration > Site Maintenance page you can set up “Down For Maintenance” features to use in your web-store.

Updating Down For Maintenance: ON/OFF

1. From the Admin Panel click the **Configuration** link and select the **Site Maintenance** item.



2. Since the **Down For Maintenance: ON/OFF** item is highlighted, click the **Edit** button on the right.



- Select the **True** button to turn the page on displaying the following information: «*The site is currently down for maintenance. Please excuse the dust and try back later*». This feature can be used when you want to temporarily stop access to the frontend, while updating some information in the Admin Panel (backend).



- Select the **False** button to open access to your web-store frontend.
3. Click the **Update** button.

Updating Down For Maintenance: File Name


1. From the Admin Panel click the **Configuration** link and select the **Site Maintenance** item.
2. Select the **Down For Maintenance: file name** item in the list and click the **Edit** button on the right.

3. There is a default Down for Maintenance file name in the field: **down_for_maintenance.php**. You can change this name if it is needed.



2. Select the **Down For Maintenance (exclude this IP-Address)** item in the list and click the **Edit** button on the right.

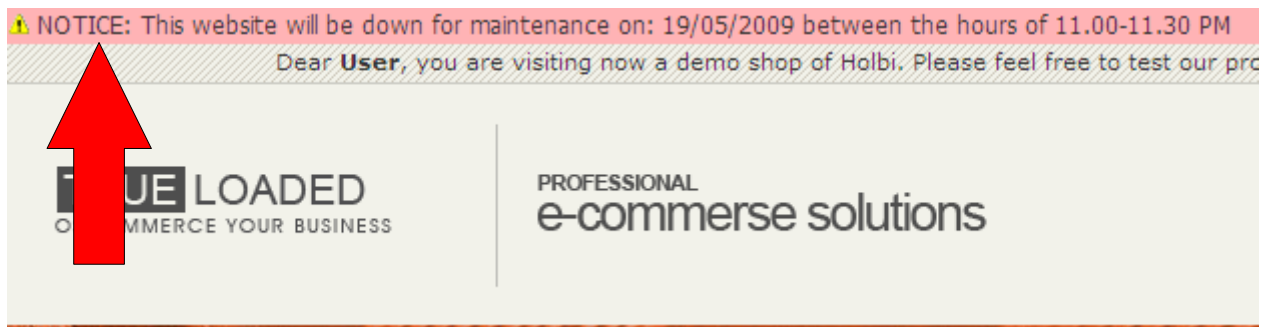
3. In the field, specify the IP Address which is able to access the website (like webmaster) while it is in the “Down for Maintenance” mode.
4. Click the **Update** button.

1. From the Admin Panel click the **Configuration** link and select the **Site Maintenance** item.
2. Select the **NOTIFY PUBLIC Before Going To Down For Maintenance: ON/OFF** item in the list and click the **Edit** button on the right.

- Select the **True** button to show the WARNING some time before you put your website Down for Maintenance. This warning will be displayed at the top of the page until the Down for Maintenance mode is turned ON.



- Select the **False** button if you do not want to show the WARNING some time before you put your website Down for Maintenance.

Note: If you set the 'Down for Maintenance: ON/OFF' to "True", this will be updated to "False" automatically .

3. Click the **Update** button.

Updating Date And Hours For Notice Before Maintenance

1. From the Admin Panel click the **Configuration** link and select the **Site Maintenance** item.
2. Select the **Date And Hours For Notice Before Maintenance** item in the list and click the **Edit** button.

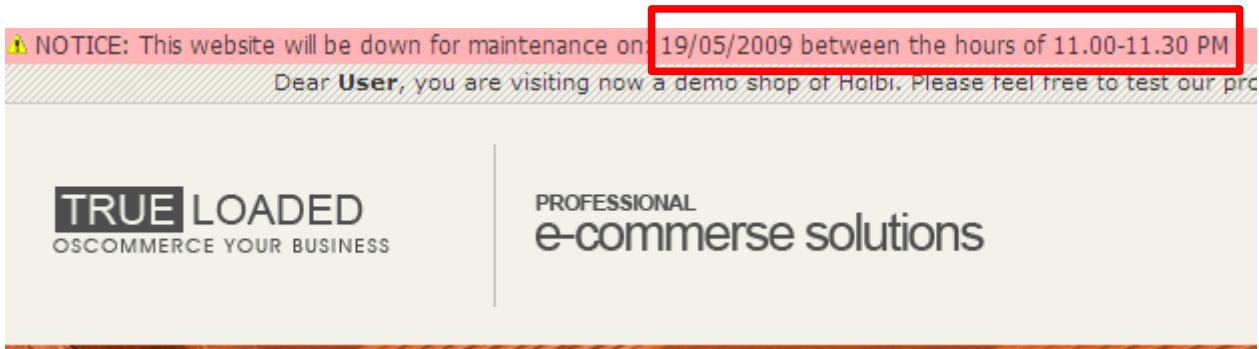

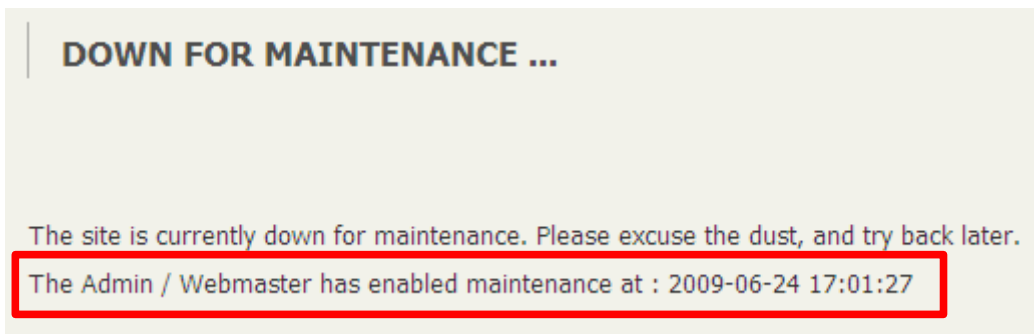


Updating Display When Webmaster Has Enabled Maintenance

1. From the Admin Panel click the **Configuration** link and select the **Site Maintenance** item.
2. Select the **Display When Webmaster Has Enabled Maintenance** item in the list and click the **Edit** button.

- Select the **True** button to display date and time when a webmaster has enabled maintenance. The users will be shown the following information, for example: “*The Admin / Webmaster has enabled maintenance at : 2009-06-24 17:01:27*”.



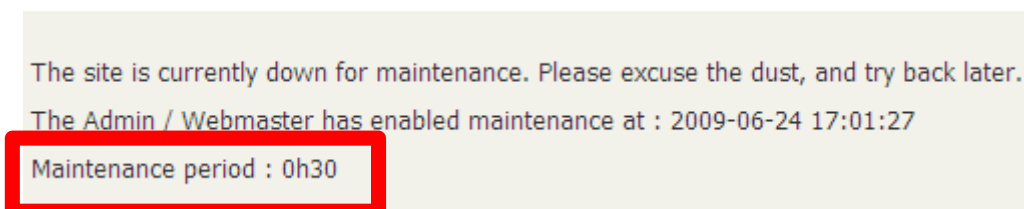
- Select the **False** button if you do not want to display this information on the page.
3. Click the **Update** button.

Updating Display Website Maintenance Period

1. From the Admin Panel click the **Configuration** link and select the **Site Maintenance** item.
2. Select the **Display Website Maintenance Period** item in the list and click the **Edit** button.
