Introduction

Shipping Modules give the store owner a way to enable/disable the shipping options available to a customer during checkout. On the checkout page, these modules are called to calculate the final shipping and packaging costs for an order. A price can be affected by a number of products ordered, products weight, as well as any other configuration settings set either in the Shipping module or in the Configuration settings page.

Shipping modules come with six modules built into the code, although only the Flat Rate module is installed initially. Installing a module can be done by clicking on the **Install** button, and editing can be done by clicking on the **Edit** button. A module can have its settings edited only after it has been installed.

If other shipping modules are placed in the code from the community contributions site, these will need to be installed in the same manner as the ones listed below before using.

Federal Express Module

1. From the Admin Panel click the **Modules** link and select the **Shipping Modules** item.

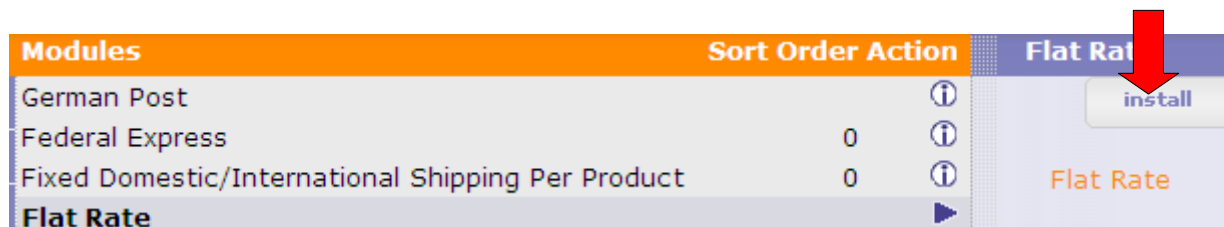

Per Item Module

In Per Item shipping the price specified in the Shipping Cost field is multiplied by the number of products ordered, and then added to the Handling Fee (if any) to calculate the final shipping cost.

Table Rate Module

The Table Rate charging sets the price for shipping based on the total weight or total cost of the products ordered. The weight (or price) is looked up in a table to find the matching range, and then that price is applied. This is similar to the Flat Rate charging but with different levels.

2. Select the **Table Rate** item in the list and click the **Edit** button on the right. If this module has not been installed, you can install it by clicking the **Install** button on the right.

The United States Postal Service (USPS) shipping module takes the total weight of the products ordered along with the packaging type specified in the configuration settings, and interacts with the USPS website to calculate the total price. Note, you should have an account with USPS to use this module.

Note: The USPS expects you to use pounds as a weight measure for your products.

1. From the Admin Panel click the **Modules** link and select the **Shipping Modules** item.
2. Select the **United States Postal Service** item in the list and click the **Edit** button on the right. If this module has not been installed, you can install it by clicking the **Install** button on the right.

Zone Rates

The Zone Rate shipping is similar to the Table Rate one mentioned above. If a customer lives in the areas specified by the configuration settings, and the Zone Rate shipping is enabled, they will be able to choose this method on frontend. The total weight of the customer's order is looked up in a table, and that price is used as the shipping cost.

1. From the Admin Panel click the **Modules** link and select the **Shipping Modules** item.
2. Select the **Zone Rates** item in the list and click the **Edit** button on the right. If this module has not been installed, you can install it by clicking the **Install** button on the right.

Shipping Modules Properties

In this section we describe the Shipping Modules properties that can be setup from the Edit Mode of each module.

Fedex Account Number (for Federal Express Module)

In this field, specify the Federal Express Account Number assigned to you (it is required).

Your Fedex Meter ID (for Federal Express Module)

In this field, specify the Federal Express Meter ID assigned to you, or set to NONE to obtain a new meter number.

cURL Path (for Federal Express Module)

In this field, specify a path to the cURL program. Or, leave this set to NONE to execute cURL using PHP.

Debug Mode (for Federal Express Module)

The False button is set by default. Select the True button to activate the debug mode.

Weight Units (for Federal Express Module)

Select the weight units in which the shipping product will be measured: LBS or KGS.

Which Server To Use

Select either Test or Production type of server to use for the shipping method. (The Production means real server used for enabling shipping).

First Line Of Street Address (for Federal Express Module)

In this field, specify the first line for the shipping from your street address (it is required).

Second Line Of Street Address (for Federal Express Module)

In this field, specify the second line for the shipping from your street address. Leave it set to NONE if you do not need to specify the second line.

City Name (for Federal Express Module)

In this field, specify the city name for the shipping from your address (it is required).

State or Province Name (for Federal Express Module)

In this field, specify the 2 letter of the state or province name for the shipping from your address (it is required for Canada and US).

Postal Code (for Federal Express Module)

In this field, specify the postal code for the shipping from your address (it is required).

Phone Number (for Federal Express Module)

In the field, specify the contact phone number for your company (it is required).

Drop off type (for Federal Express Module)

In this field, specify the drop off type by a certain number (1 = regular pickup, 2 = request courier, 3 = drop box, 4 = drop at BSC, 5 = drop at station).

Display Transit Times (for Federal Express Module)

The True button is set by default. That means the transit times for ground or home delivery rates will be shown. Select the False button if you wish to disable this feature.

Fedex Surcharge (for Federal Express Module)

In this field, set whether a surcharge amount must be added to the shipping charge. (1=add surcharge; 0=do not add surcharge).

Insurance (for Federal Express Module)

In this field, specify a dollar amount over which the packages must be insured.

Residential Surcharge (for Federal Express Module)

In this field, set whether a Residential Surcharge must be added (in addition to other surcharge) for Express packages within US or ground packages within Canada. (1=add residential surcharge; 0=do not add residential surcharge).

Enable Envelope Rates (for Federal Express Module)

The False button is set by default. Select the True button if you want to offer the Fedex Envelope rates. All items under 1/2 LB (.23KG) will quote using the envelope rate.

Sort Rates (for Federal Express Module)

Select a sort rate for shipping: either High to Low or Low to High.

Timeout In Seconds (for Federal Express Module)

In this field, specify the maximum time in seconds you would wait for a rate request from Federal Express. Leave it set to NONE for default timeout.

Tax Class

In the dropdown list select a tax class to use on the shipping fee.

Sort Order Of Display

The Sort Order field associated with each module describes in what order the modules will be presented to a customer during checkout. The modules will always be displayed in alphabetical order in the Administrative tool, regardless of the Sort Order field. Changing the Sort Order can be done by editing the settings for that particular module, but cannot be done at the main shipping modules screen. The sorting is done with the lowest number representing the top of the displayed list, except for modules with a value of 0, which are put at the bottom. These are sorted alphabetically.

eBay (for Fixed Shipping Module)

The False button is set by default. Select the True button if you wish to offer the fixed shipping prices for eBay orders that contain additional shopping cart items.

Display Shipping Modules (for Fixed Shipping Module)

The False button is set by default. Select the True button if you wish to disable all other shipping methods when Fixed Shipping is enabled.

Shipping Zone (for Fixed Shipping Module)

In the dropdown list select a shipping zone for this shipping method. If a zone is selected, just enable this shipping method for that zone.

Multiple Item Discount (for Fixed Shipping Module)

In this field, specify the percentage discount that you offer to customers who purchase multiple items. Ex: 20% = 20;

Cost Minimum (for Fixed Shipping Module)

In this field, specify the minimum product's cost for which an insurance will be charged.

Cost Multiple (for Fixed Shipping Module)

In this field, specify the increment of product cost for which an additional insurance will be charged.

Base Insurance (for Fixed Shipping Module)

In the field, specify the minimum insurance amount to charge.

Add Insurance (for Fixed Shipping Module)

In the field, specify the additional insurance amount to charge.

Shipping Cost

In this field, specify the shipping cost for all orders using this shipping method.

Handling Fee

In this field, specify a handling fee for this shipping method.

Percentage Rate (for Percent Shipping Module)

In this field, specify the Percentage Rate all .01 to .99 for all orders using this shipping method.

A Flat Rate For Orders Under (for Percent Shipping Module)

In the field, specify a price for orders. All the orders that cost less than this amount will be assigned with a flat rate.

A Flat Rate Of (for Percent Shipping Module)

In this field, specify a flat rate used for all orders. This value is associated with the field described above (“A Flat Rate For Orders Under”), for example, if you specify '10' in the “A Flat Rate Of” field and '100' in the “A Flat Rate For Orders Under”, the shipping price for orders that cost less than \$100 will be \$10.

Shipping Table (for Table Rate Module)

In this field, specify the shipping cost based on the total cost or weight of items. For example, if you put the “25:8.50,50:5.50” values in this field, all the orders up to 25 (\$ or kg) will be charged by \$8.50, from 25 to 50 – will be charged by \$5.50, etc.

Table Method (for Table Rate Module)

Select the “Weight” radio button to show that the shipping cost is based on the total weight of the items ordered. Or, select the “Price” radio button to show that the shipping cost is based on the order total price.

This property is associated with the field described above (“Shipping Table”). For example, if you select the “Weight” button in the “Table Method” box and specify the “25:8.50,50:5.50” value in the “Shipping Table” field, then an order with the total weight of 25kg (or less) will be charged by \$8.50, the order with the total weight of 25 to 50kg will be charged by \$5.50.

PickUp Method (for United Parcel Service)

In this field, specify how you give packages to UPS. Use one of the following abbreviations:

CC - Customer Counter,
RDP - Daily Pickup,
OTP - One Time Pickup,
LC - Letter Center,
OCA - On Call Air

Packaging (for United Parcel Service)

In this field, specify the packaging type. Use one of the following abbreviations:

CP - Your Packaging,
ULE - UPS Letter,
UT - UPS Tube,
UBE - UPS Express Box

Residential Delivery (for United Parcel Service)

In this field, specify a Quote either for Residential (RES) or Commercial Delivery (COM).

User ID (for United States Postal Service Module)

In this field, specify the USPS (US Postal Service) User ID assigned to you.

USPS Options (for United States Postal Service Module)

Here you can select the following USPS options: Display weight and/or Display transit time.

Domestic Shipping Methods (for United States Postal Service Module)

Here you can select the following domestic services to be offered: Express, Priority, First Class, Parcel.

Zone 1 Countries (for Zone Rates Module)

In this field, specify the comma separated list of two character ISO country codes that are part of Zone 1.

Zone 1 Shipping Table (for Zone Rates Module)

In this field, specify shipping rates to Zone 1 destinations based on a group of maximum order weights. For example, specify “3:8.50” in the field. Weights less than or equal to 3kg will cost \$8.50 for Zone 1 destinations.
